In the light of the tumultuous events of our time, many of us have been looking for deeper insights into our current events and the needs of our time. It seems to be an appropriate time to turn our thoughts to the work of the late Carl Stegmann, who lived and worked in this community in the 1970's and 80's.

Mr. Stegmann, a native of Germany, was one of the founding members of the Movement for Religious Renewal," also known as the Christian Community." Inspired by indications of Rudolf Steiner. Carl was inspired by the works of Rudolf Steiner that this part of the world would have a significant role to play in the decisive challenges at the turn of the century. At an advanced age he moved to California and was significant in the founding of "The Sacramento Center for Anthroposophical Studies," which later became Rudolf Steiner College.

In his book <u>The Other America</u>, Carl Stegmann gathered insights from many of Rudolf Steiner's indications about events that would take place in the coming decades.

Inspired and guided by his work, the Faust Branch is planning to dedicate our work this winter to studying the spiritual foundations of America from the perspective of Anthroposophy. You are encouraged to read "The Other America" by Carol Stegmann.
